The following Release Notes highlight four key feature upgrades within Asset Point, as well as additional enhancements:

- PDF Elevations & Floor Plans Across Any Browser
- Support for XLSX Excel File Formats
- Updates to the Graphical User Interface (GUI)
- Improvements to application navigation menu

# 1) PDF Version & Floor Plans Across Any Browser

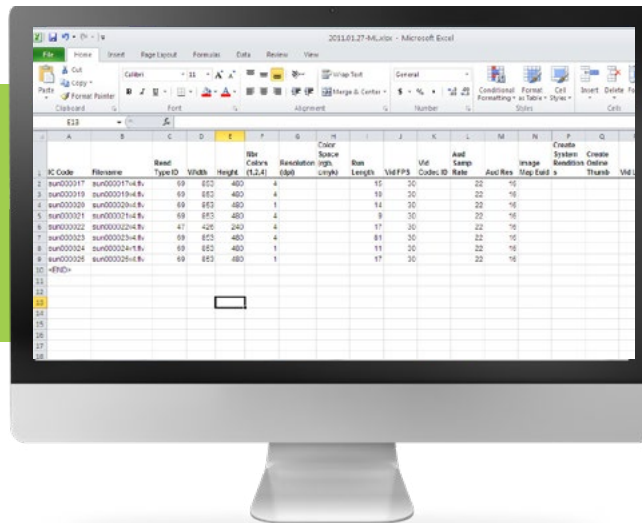
One of the major enhancements of this release is that users will now be able to view PDF versions of cabinet elevations and floor plans on any browser. In the previous version, graphics functionality was limited to the Internet Explorer browser using Visio Viewer. With this enhancement, we are now converting Visio drawings to PDF so that users can access the graphics on any browser.

Users will still be able to view the Visio version within IE and use Draw Client functionality as they previously did.



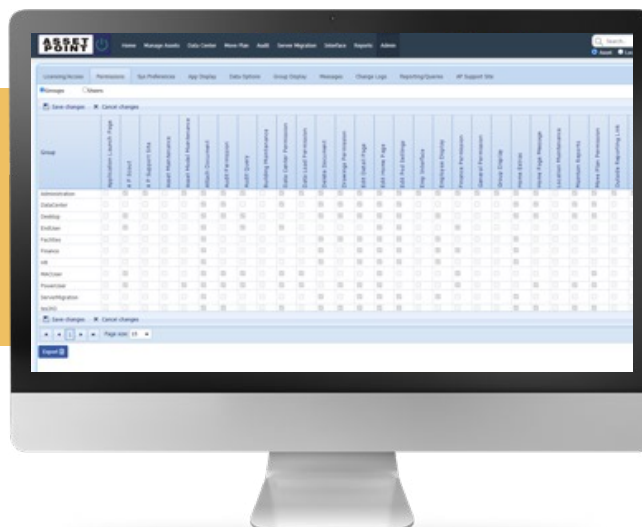
## 2) Support for XLSX Excel File Formats

Asset Point 7.2.2 will support XLSX Excel file formats. Users will be able to import and export data using the latest Excel format.



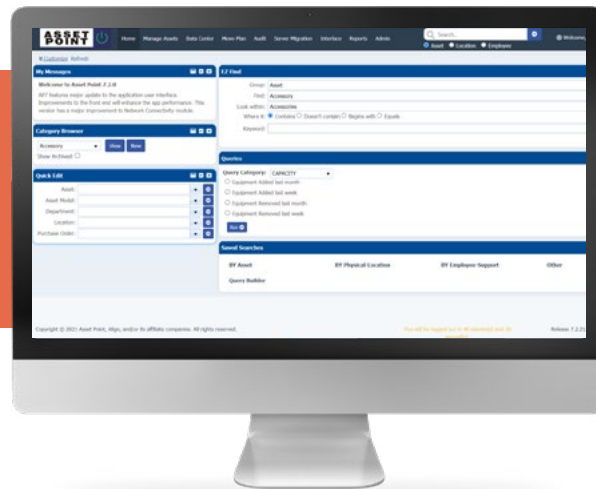
## 3) Enhanced Theme & User Interface for Administration Module

We continued to enhance the Admin Module with the latest Asset Point Theme. Users will now enjoy a modern GUI Style within the Asset Point platform, featuring the new colour scheme, fonts and sizes.



## 4) Enhanced Page Layout & Navigation

We have improved the Asset Point page layout; the application menu is fixed on the top so that users can navigate the site easily.



## Additional Enhancements

Aside from the four noted upgrades, user feedback helped drive other enhancements noted below

- 🔌 **Additional Security on Asset, Cabinet, and Building Tables** – Asset Point 7.2.2 has improved the security around various tables. Asset Point Admin can manage the group-level and user-level permissions, as well as restrict any group or user to update these.
- 🔌 **More User-Defined Fields** – Introduced ten new user-defined fields on IT Room and Building Tables. These enhancements will provide additional flexibility for clients when storing data.
- 🔌 **Location Table Enhancement** – Increased cabinet ID field length to 36 characters.
- 🔌 **Power Strip Table** – New fields added to the Power Strip Table including “Asset Tag” and “Serial Number.”
- 🔌 **Store AD group in Asset Point User Table** – This feature can be used to troubleshoot LDAP user login issues.
- 🔌 **Progress bar** - New improvements added to page load bar.
- 🔌 **Colour Scheme Enhancements** – New grid selection options.
- 🔌 **Advanced Search under Managed Assets Menu** – Users can now easily access advanced search functionality.
- 🔌 **New Login Error Message** – Users will get a more distinct login error message if they are not a part of any Asset Point mapped groups.
- 🔌 **User Login Enhancement** – If a user group changes or is removed from AD group, Asset Point will now clean the table and remove all data.
- 🔌 **Updated Audit Trail** – Improved troubleshooting for user and Query Builder saved searches.
- 🔌 **New Loading Page Pop Up** – A message will display while running a query in Query Builder.
- 🔌 **Session Timeout Message** – This message has been updated to be more clear.
